Organ System	Acute Complications (Days-Months After Treatment)	Late Complications (Months-Years After Treatment)
General	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fatigue 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fatigue Secondary cancers caused by radiation (Extremely rare)
Skin	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Redness/irritation 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Darkening/tanning over treated area
Lungs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shortness of breath Cough 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shortness of breath Lung inflammation (often not requiring treatment, but visible on imaging) Chest wall discomfort Rib fracture (extremely rare)
Throat	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Soreness or pain when swallowing 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Narrowing of the esophagus causing difficulty swallowing
Digestive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nausea
